## FOR CIRCULATION AMONG ALL UNIT MEMBERS

Haryana College Teachers' Association (HCTA) vehemently wish to inform all the teacher members of HCTA college units that the Government of Haryana **has transferred the arrears bills of last 10 years of NPS amounting to approximately Rs 23 crores to the NSDL accounts of teachers appointed after 2006 in the Govt. aided colleges of Haryana.** HCTA has worked relentlessly and continuously during the last 6 years for its implementation and met the DGHE and Principal Secretary higher education on numerous occasions for it, the recent meeting being on 16 March 2017. This is a moment for rejoice and celebration for all of us and all units should celebrate it in the meetings of their college units.

**The issue of HRA up to 20 Kms and Spouse case has also been accepted** by the Government in principle. The issue of HRA beyond 20 Kms has been sought and clarification in this regard will soon be issued by the Finance Department. HCTA will keep pursuing this urgent issue seriously.

Due to the inexorable efforts of HCTA, **provision has been made by the HEC office for paying salary up to the month of February 2017 and Rs 55 Crores has been sanctioned by the Finance Department of Haryana for this purpose.** All college teachers are requested ask their respective college offices to send their salary bills to the HEC office at the earliest so that their salaries can be disbursed. HCTA is persistently pursuing other vital issues of teachers and will soon meet the Chief Minister and Finance Minister of Haryana for the prompt implementation of Medical Facility for the teachers of Govt. aided colleges of Haryana. All the long pending and cherished demands of teachers will be staidly and seriously pursued by HCTA.
