We wish to submit that there is no medical facility available so far for the staff of Govt. Aided Colleges in the state. In this matter we met the Hon'ble Chief Minister and submitted this demand in February 2015 and in response to our demand the Hon'ble Chief Minister desired that appropriate draft scheme may be initiated (copy enclosed). Even after lapse of period of one year and five months no action has been initiated by the Higher Education Department. It is further submitted that this demand of medical facility was placed before your good-self in the last convention of HCTA held on 15/01/2017 at A.I. Jat H.M. College, Rohtak. We again earnestly request you to grant medical facility to the Teaching, Non-Teaching and Retired Staff of Govt. Aided Colleges of the State at par with the staff members of Govt. Colleges in the State. It is pertinent to mention that the Higher Education Department has already assessed the likely expenditure to be incurred in the medical facility on the pattern of Govt. Colleges of the State.
