Subject : Urgent Problems of the Teachers of Affiliated Colleges Regarding Ph.D. Regulations.

Respected Sir,

With due regards, we request you resolve following issues concerning Ph.D. registration, Ph.D. course work and permission of supervising Ph.D. research:

1. Regular teachers should be exempted from Ph.D. entrance test. MDU has done it. A decision in this regard should be taken without any further delay.
2. The University should give clear guidelines to affiliated colleges regarding the leave to be availed for attending Ph.D. course work. For this teachers should be given Academic Leave. The university needs to instruct the colleges on this particular issue so that Ph.D. course is not used to deny research opportunity to the teachers.
3. We request you to allow college teachers in all subjects, both UG and PG teachers, to supervise Ph.D. research. Despite the fact that the Ph.D. Ordinance of KUK allows it, in practice it is yet to implemented in all subjects. Here we would like to stress the urgency of this particular issue as the rampant corruption in research degrees is on the rise due to private players in higher education. There should be no condition of infrastructural research facilities in the colleges.

We request you to treat these issues with due urgency as there is a widespread resentment in the teaching fraternity of affiliated colleges .
