

Respected Sir,


HCTA humbly wish to draw your kind attention to the Order No. 2/129/2016 CII (1) dated 22.12.2016 regarding HRA wherein in Para 2 it has been mentioned that the staff "must get the affidavits attested/ verified from Tehsildar/ Revenue officer concerned." When many of the teachers went for verification of their HRA affidavits, some of the Thesildars/ Revenue officers refused to attest them and handed over to them the copies of Haryana Govt. Notification No. 2/10/2013-4FR/1669 dated 19 July 2016 and letter issued by the Chief Secretary regarding abolition of affidavits and allowing self-certification vide DO no. 62/09/2010-6GS1 dated 14.9.2016 (Copies attached of both) and asked them to certify it themselves. Kindly clarify this matter at the earliest.

Moreover, you are also requested to interpret and clarify clause 14 (2) (b) of DHE order (Copy attached) since the same has been mentioned in the Haryana Govt. Notification of 19 July 2016.

"place of posting or actual residence, whichever is less, if he is residing at a place which is at a distance more than twenty kilometers outer limit of the municipal limits of place of posting."

You are kindly requested to clarify that those who are residing beyond the limit of twenty kilometers, can claim HRA also.

Subject: Passing of salary bills from month of January, 2017.

Respected Sir,

The Director Higher Education Haryana office is not passing the salary bills of 97 aided colleges of Haryana due to-

1. Office (C-II branch) is seeking clarification regarding instructions of Haryana Govt. vide its Gaz. Sept. 20, 2016, No. 2/10/2013-4FR/1669, particularly pays 908 at point no. 14-2(a&b) and Note putted in continuation of above point (copy attached).
2. However, in point no. 14-3, Note is self explanatory "However house rent allowance shall be admissible to all if more than one member of a family are residing together in one and the same own house".
3. The Gaz. Notification is applicable to all employees of Haryana State, why not for us?

Although instructions in above mentioned Gaz., things are clear and self explanatory, even the concerned official is not trying to understand these. He is asking verbally to give salary statements of spouses of employees and assessment of their houses from PWD(B&R), HUDA and MC's of that places. It is nowhere mentioned in this Gaz. Notification. He is not given anything in writing to officials who come from Colleges to get salary bills passed.

This autocratic behavior of official causing harassment to all employees serving in aided colleges.

You are hereby requested to instruct the DHE office in this regard.
